Behavioral Caregiver Training



Behavioral Caregiver Training (BCT) is designed for caregivers who are struggling with how to address or manage a member's challenging behaviors. This is a low-intensity (1-2 sessions per week) and short-term service (approx. 8-12 sessions) focusing on training caregivers in basic behavioral strategies rooted in applied behavior analysis. This service may be provided in-person in Flagstaff or via telehealth across Northern Arizona, and to caregivers of both child and adult members.

Referrals for BCT services may be declined for members whose behavioral needs exceed the ability to be served safely and effectively via this service. For BCT services that will be provided to caregivers in group home or day program settings, a 30-min teaming with the member or guardian and group home/day program staff is required before a referral is accepted.

FBA with Caregiver Training



A Functional Behavioral Assessment (FBA) is a process for identifying the function(s) of challenging behaviors and developing interventions to prevent or reduce those behaviors, and to teach functional alternative behaviors. Following the completion of an FBA including a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP), caregivers are trained on the strategies outlined in the BIP. This service may be provided in-person in the greater Flagstaff area or via telehealth across Northern Arizona for members with less severe challenging behaviors, and to both child and adult members.

Referrals for telehealth-only FBA services may be declined for members whose behavioral needs exceed the ability to be served safely and effectively via telehealth. For FBA services to members in group home or day program settings, a 30-minute teaming is required with the member or guardian and group home/day program leadership before a referral is accepted.

Clinic-Based ABA



Clinic-based Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services are for children who are ages 0-12 and would benefit from a structured environment away from home. Based upon clinical need and child/family schedules, children attend the clinic between 4-30 hours per week. Following an ABA assessment, this service requires a prior authorization (for most health plans) and 6-month commitment. Services are provided by a team of Behavior Technicians and a Licensed Behavior Analyst.

Referrals may be declined for members with significant medical or physical issues that impede their ability to engage in services, or for members who exhibit behaviors that pose a significant risk to themselves or others. Our clinic in Flagstaff is open from 9 AM to 5 PM daily for services.

Community-Based ABA



Community-based ABA services are provided in home or community settings where the member is needing most support. These services are available to who are ages 0-17 and require a minimum of 4 hours per week commitment. Following an ABA assessment, this service requires a prior authorization (for most health plans) and 6-month commitment. Services are provided by a team of Behavior Technicians and a Licensed Behavior Analyst.

Referrals may be declined for members with significant medical or physical issues that impede their ability to engage in services, or members who exhibit behaviors that pose a significant risk to themselves or others. These services are available only in the greater Flagstaff area.
